  - 1. Modesto: Korey Keith: Has been working on the government transitions. Yesterday was the opening ceremony for our long awaited student lounge. Had our annual Summer Sonata that is put on by the District for scholarship fundraising. Had our first Senate meeting on July 11- was very effective. Also thanks Bakersfield for hosting. Andrew Campbell: Says that ASMJC Senator, Taeilorae Levell is organizing a Future Women in Leadership conference to be held sometime in March of 2014.

- **2.** Bakersfield: Travis Appointed to Region V chair for the Black Caucus talks about the African American male mental projects to help support them as average GPA is 1.4. So we need to help support these men and women to help them achieve their goals. Shelby Sward: Having issues with their District as well as their Advisor and obtaining funds for items like travel expenses. They had a financial aid rep 30.7% going into default for student loans so they are working on developing a support group. They are on a 3 year warning. If they don't improve they will stop funding financial aid if the default percentage doesn't improve. Concerned that the student population would be severely compromised if this happens. Most students rely on student aide in order to attend college and many probably would not attend if there is no financial aid. Would like to incorporate help regionally if not statewide. Matt has asked for more information so we can help. "Is this school level or district level? Stated is at school level. They may possibly have some workshops: Theme is: "Know before you owe" Also wondering how to get students involved with the student government at the local level. Asks MJC how they (with 26 Senators) have been so successful with getting students involved. Campbell- states that students aren't really interested in advocacy more into Student Life. Costa- also states that ICC is a very important part of getting people involved. Lists examples of student senate positions.
- 3. Columbia: ASO does not formally meet during the summer however they have been meeting as it is necessary. Focus is on Student Life and putting on a job fair. Food always helps. Have a BBQ and pass out pamphlets. Kim coordinated table with food, business cards, newspapers, shirts, club info, pretty much everything you can think of put that out there. During welcome week go to classes pass out flyers- cookie for filling out a survey. They are having a retreat next week, MJC is invited. Will provide food, workshops, fun and games. Put together furniture for the ASO and then moved their office as it was way too small. Very nice. Went to college council mtg. Manzanita bldg, is getting remolded part of Measure E bond so most of campus is going to be under construction so they are working with facilities to provide signage with directional signs to point students in the right direction.

- **5.** Reedley: Just had a training Wednesday. It was their ASG, Fresno City and groups under their umbrella. State student leadership training; talked about Roberts Rules, how to run an effective meeting, etc. Will be holding biweekly meetings to get all involved. Their ASG is not active during the summer but will be meeting soon.
